2008 National Convention Notice – August 31, 2007

To: All AMFA Locals

Re: 2008 National Convention

In accordance with Article XII, Section 1 of the AMFA Constitution, this letter shall serve as the official notice of the 2008 AMFA National Convention.

The delegates to the 2004 National Convention elected to have the 2008 National Convention in Orlando, Florida. Therefore, the NEC has chosen the Radisson World gate Resort in Kissimmee, Florida as the site of the 2008 National Convention.

A welcoming reception will be held on Sunday, May 4, 2008, to kick-off the Convention. Official National Convention business will commence Monday, May 5, 2008 and will end no later than Friday, May 9, 2008.

In accordance with Article XII, Section 6 of the AMFA Constitution, Locals must elect their delegates for the 2008 National Convention within sixty (60) days of this notice. Reference Article XII, Section 4 of the AMFA Constitution to determine how many delegates your Local shall elect. Upon completion of this election, please submit your delegates and alternates to the National Secretary as soon as possible.

In accordance with Article VII, Section 2 of the AMFA Constitution, each Local delegation may nominate one (1) candidate for each National Officer position at the National Convention. Because each Local delegation can only nominate one candidate per position, Locals/delegates should begin this process with adequate time to conduct a run-off election, if necessary.
