The first week of January I participated on the NEC Conference Call, worked to resolve internal email issues with our server, policy revisions, reviewing/correcting and approving invoices, expense reports, and such.

The second week, after the NEC Conference call, I worked on making preparations for the quarterly Joint Advisory Council (JAC) meeting. The Local and National leadership and Airline Representatives will be meeting the second week of February to discuss matters of importance to the Association.
