The last week of March and the first week of April, I participated on the NEC conference call, made and finalized preparations for the debate with the IBT for our Horizon members, and enabled our Web site to telecast the live debate. I also worked on compiling, photos, statements, and other information for creating flyers and posting for the Horizon members in regard to the representation election between AMFA and the IBT.

The second week of April, I participated on the NEC Conference Call worked on flyers for mailings to our Horizon members, JAC meeting preparations, processing invoices, making appointments for the next NEC/LEC conference call, and answering bylaws questions.
