Nomination Notice

Alternate AMFA-Alaska Airlines ASAP ERC Representative

AMFA National is accepting nominations for an election to fill the position of Alternate AMFA-Alaska Airlines (ASA) Aviation Safety Action Program (ASAP) Event Review Committee (ERC) Representative.

The Primary AMFA ASAP Representative serves as the Alaska Airlines membership's representative on the ASA ASAP ERC and reports to the National Safety & Standards Director or his designee. This position is anticipated to be a full-time assignment based in Seattle, Washington. The **Alternate Representative** will serve in the event the Primary is unavailable. The term of service for the Alternate Representative will commence on July 1, 2011, and will expire at 11:59 PM ET, June 30, 2013, or upon termination of the program, whichever occurs first.

This nomination process and election will be conducted in accordance with AMFA's general election procedures for officers. Candidates for this position must be active members in good standing, employed by Alaska Airlines, and free of all assessments and fines to the National and Local.

Nomination forms are available on the Local 14 website—go to www.amfa14.org, drag your pointer over the *Forms* tab at the top of the homepage, and select the item labeled *AMFA-ASA ASAP ERC Rep Nomination Form* from the dropdown menu.

Nominations must be submitted in writing to the Local 14 Secretary, Tom Thurber, no later than 5:00 pm PST on March 16, 2011—the day of the March Local Meeting. Nomination forms can be submitted in person, by fax or via US mail using the information in the letterhead at the top of this page. Forms can also be submitted electronically by saving a copy to your desktop, completing the form, saving all changes, attaching it to an email and sending it to: secretary@amfa14.org. (Adobe Reader 8 or later is required to save changes to the form if submitting electronically.)

All nominees will be required to verify their candidacy by completing and returning a *Willingness to Serve Form*, which will be mailed to each nominee by AMFA National following the close of the nomination period.

Information about the voting process, including the ballot package mailing date and the ballot count-date, will be announced following the close of the nomination period.
