Nominations per AMFA Local 14 Bylaws

ARTICLE IV: ELECTION OF LOCAL OFFICERS AND REPRESENTATIVES

To be nominated for any Local officer position except that of Airline Representative, a member shall be in good standing, an active or associate member, attended fifty per cent (50%) of regular Local meetings held during the last year, six meetings total, or present to the Local Secretary a nominating petition containing signatures (valid as certified by the Local Secretary) of 10% of the members in good standing in the Local (this petition must be submitted when nominations are accepted at the Local meeting), and have been free of all fines and assessments to the National and Local for the preceding twelve months prior to nomination (except for the first election after receiving charter). Members who are unable to attend a meeting because of verified illness, death in the family, vacation, official Association business, or because they reside and work beyond a fifty mile radius of where the meeting is held will be given credit for having attended that meeting for purposes of meeting the minimum attendance requirements (this proof must be submitted when nominations are accepted at the Local meeting).

Nominees for the position of Airline Representative are subject to the above criteria, but must have attended fifty percent (50%) of regular Local meetings held during the two years preceding nomination, twelve meetings total, reference National Constitution Article X Section 3(C).

The Number of Members required for Alaska Airlines ALR Petition will be 50

AIRLINE REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES AND RESPONSABILITIES PER AMFA LOCAL 14 BYLAWS
ARTICLE III Section 2 F.

Airline Representative - The duties of Airline Representative shall be to thoroughly familiarize himself with the contract agreement between the airline whose members he represents with the Local and this Association. He shall also select, with approval of Local Executive Council, any Shop Representative or Area Representative positions the members have not filled by election, within his airline at his location. He will be a coordinator for the Area Representatives and Shop Representatives to the Local Executive Council and provide the Area Representatives and Shop Representatives with accurate, up-to-date information on all contract interpretation and grievance matters. He shall be a member of the Grievance Committee. Attendance at the monthly Airline Representative meeting is mandatory. Three absences in succession for any reason except while on Association business, death in the family, vacation or for personal medical reasons shall deem his position vacant. An Airline Representative may be recalled from office in accordance with the provisions of Article XIV, Section 1 of the National Constitution upon written request to the Local President by twenty-five percent (25%) of the members in good standing of the airline with the Local.

The Airline Representative will communicate as deemed necessary to keep the Area Representative(s) up-to-date regarding grievances, negotiations, and contractual interpretations. Prior to ratification, the Airline Representative will call a meeting to acquaint the new contract to the Area Representative(s).

The Airline Representative, each month, will present all correspondence pertaining to discipline of members to the Local Executive Council before that month's regular union meeting.

The Airline Representative shall account for all trips away from the Local office (out of town) each month to the members at the regular monthly union meeting.

The Airline Representative will be a member of the contract negotiations committee and will represent all members of Local 14 in it's contract negotiations with the Airline Representative's respective airline.

During contract negotiations the Airline Representative, of the airline in contract negotiations, will report to the Local Executive Council after each negotiating session. This reporting will allow the Airline Representative attending negotiations and the LEC to relay questions and concerns between them. Further, this will aide the LEC in providing factual and timely information to the membership.
