

AMFA ALASKA AIR NTSB GO TEAM SELF NOMINATION FORM

December 6, 2007

We currently have openings for AMFA ASA NTSB Go Team members. The current openings require expertise in one or more of the following aircraft maintenance skills: Structures, Systems, Powerplant, and Maintenance Records. Two Aircraft Maintenance Technicians will be selected for each skill set. Team members assist in NTSB investigations if the need arises in their field of expertise.

This is a voluntary non-elected self nominated position selected by the AMFA National Safety and Standard Director, AMFA ASA NTSB Go Team Party Coordinator, and AMFA Local 14 Safety and Standard Chairman. Candidates will be asked to provide aircraft knowledge and related experience. A standard set of interview questions will be asked of each candidate. Technical knowledge and ability to handle stressful situations will be evaluated. Candidates must be members in good standing.

As an AMFA ASA NTSB Go Team member you will be on-call for immediate assignment. Personal affairs should be arranged to allow for departure to the scene of the accident with minimum delay regardless of when you are notified. It may be necessary to keep additional clothing and essentials at work. You will be required to provide and maintain current contact information to AMFA ASA NTSB Go Team Party Coordinator, AMFA Local 14 Safety and Standards Chairman and AMFA Safety and Standards Director.

Necessary training will be provided and your expertise and technical knowledge is a valued asset. NTSB party status is extended to organizations able to provide technical assistance to the investigation. Bloodborne pathogen training is provided and hepatitis series inoculations are required. Personal Protective Equipment and investigative tools are provided by AMFA.
