Nomination Notice

Primary and Alternate AMFA-Alaska Airlines ASAP ERC Representatives

AMFA National is accepting nominations for an election to fill the positions of Primary and Alternate AMFA-Alaska Airlines (ASA) Aviation Safety Action Program (ASAP) Event Review Committee (ERC) Representatives. The Primary AMFA ASAP Representative will serve as the Alaska Airlines membership's representative on the ASAP ERC. The Alternate AMFA ASAP Representative will assume the duties of the Primary Representative in that person's absence.

This nomination process and election will be conducted in accordance with AMFA's general election procedures for officers. Candidates for this position must be active members in good standing, employed by Alaska Airlines, and free of all assessments and fines to the National and Local.

At this time it is anticipated that the Primary AMFA ERC Representative will serve on a full-time basis. The ERC Representative will be required to attend regularly scheduled meetings of the ERC. The term of service will commence July, 31, 2008, and will expire at 11:59 PM ET, June 30, 2010, or upon termination of the program, whichever occurs first.

Nominations must be submitted in writing to your Local no later than 5:00 PM on 20 March 2008.

Nomination forms may be obtained at the AMFA 14 Website @ www.AMFA14.org click on the "Forms" tab and select "Nomination and Petitions" Seattle Nominees who have not attended 6 of the last 12 General Membership Meetings will be required to submit a petition to the Secretary of Local 14 with * 41* signatures on the petition (10% of the Seattle Membership)

All nominees will be required to verify their candidacy by completing and returning a Willingness to Serve Form, which will be mailed to each nominee by AMFA National following the close of the nomination period.

Information about the voting process, including the ballot package mailing date and the ballot count date, will be announced following the close of the nomination period.

The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be declared the Primary AMFA ASAP ERC Representative. The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes will be declared the Alternate.
