Special Election Nomination Notice ASA Area Representative for PDX

To ensure that proper representation at the PDX station continues, the AMFA 14 Local Executive Council is hereby implementing the position of Area Representative for PDX (per Article XVIII Section 4 of the AMFA Constitution and Article III, Section 4 A of the Local Bylaws). Local 14 is now accepting nominations to fill this newly opened position. The term of office will begin with the close of this election process and will end at the January 2013 Regular Membership Meeting (per Article IV, Section 1 of the Local Bylaws).

The duties of the Area Representative are described in Article XVIII, Section 4 of the AMFA Constitution and Article III, Section 4 A of the Local 14 Bylaws.

Qualifications for Area Representative are detailed in the AMFA Constitution, Article XVIII, Section 4 B as follows:

Qualifications for this position shall be a member in good standing, free from delinquency of any nature to the Local or National Association, who has attended fifty percent (50%) of all regularly scheduled membership meetings held during the two years preceding nomination. Meetings that a member is unable to attend because of verified illness, death in the immediate family, vacation, official Association business, working hours, jury duty, service in the armed forces of the United States, or because they reside and work beyond a fifty mile radius of where the meeting is held will not be counted in determining such member's eligibility under this section.

Since all AMFA Local 14 members at the PDX station reside and work beyond a fifty mile radius of the location of the regular membership meeting (Seattle), the membership meeting requirement does not apply.

Nomination forms are available on the Local 14 website—go to www.amfa14.org, drag your pointer over the *FORMS* tab at the top of the homepage, and select the item labeled *Area Representative Nomination Form* from the dropdown menu.

Nomination forms must be submitted to the Local 14 Secretary no later than **5:00 pm on February 15, 2012**—the day of the February regular membership meeting—**to be held in Portland**. The nomination form can be submitted in person, by fax or by post using the information in the letterhead at the top of this page. Nomination forms can also be submitted electronically by saving a copy to your desktop, completing the form, saving all changes, attaching it to an email and sending it to: secretary@amfa14.org. (Adobe Reader 8 or later is required to save changes to the form if submitting electronically.)



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All nominees will be required to verify their candidacy by completing and returning a Willingness to Serve Form, which will be forwarded to each nominee following the close of the nomination period.

Information about the voting process, including the ballot package mailing date and the ballot count-date, will be announced following the close of the nomination period.
