# AMFA National Officer Nomination Notice Assistant National Director

The AMFA National Executive Council has begun the process to fill the position of Assistant National Director, which recently became vacant. This vacancy will be filled by a Special Election to be conducted in accordance with Article VIII, Section 1 of the AMFA Constitution.

The term of office will commence on the first day of the month following the certification of the election and will expire at 11:59 PM ET on October 7, 2012. The duties for this position may be found in Article VI Section 4 of the Constitution. At this time it is anticipated that this position will serve on a part-time, as needed basis.

All nominees will be required to verify their candidacy by completing and returning a Willingness to Serve Form, which will be mailed to each nominee by AMFA National following the close of the nomination period. Candidates for these positions must be members in good standing, Active or Active Associate Members, and free of all assessments and fines to the National and Local, per Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution.

Each Local may submit the name of one Active or Active Associate Members in good standing as a nominee for Assistant National Director in accordance with Article VII, Section 2 of the Constitution.

**Nominations must be submitted in writing to Local14 no later than 5:00 PM on 21 July 2009 Nomination forms may be obtained by contacting ALR Shop Rep, Local Officers.**

Information about the voting process, including the ballot package mailing date and the ballot count date, will be announced following the close of the nomination period.
